ORDINANCE NO. 7825

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RITTMAN, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTIES AND STATE OF OHIO, DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO PROCEED WITH THE 2013 SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR GRANDVIEW, HILLCREST AND HAWTHORNE ALL TOGETHER WITH THE NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THERETO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council has adopted Resolution No. 7761 on August 12, 2013, declaring the necessity of making the improvement described in Section One; and NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Rittman, Wayne and Medina Counties, Ohio, three-fourths of all members elected or appointed thereto concurring:

SECTION ONE.

That it is determined to proceed with the 2013 Sidewalk Improvement Project for Grandview, Hillcrest and Hawthorne, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto.

SECTION TWO.

That the improvement shall be made in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 7761 and with the plans, specifications, profiles and estimate of cost of the improvement, prepared by the City's Service Director/City Engineer and now on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.

SECTION THREE.

That no claims for damages resulting from the improvement have been legally filed.

SECTION FOUR.

That the portion of the cost of the improvement to be assessed in accordance with Resolution No. 7761 shall be assessed in the manner and the number of installments provided and on the lots and lands described, in that resolution.

SECTION FIVE.

That the estimated special assessments previously prepared and filed in the office of the Clerk of Council and as equalized by the Assessment Equalization Board are adopted.

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SECTION SIX.

That the Clerk of Council shall deliver certified copies of this ordinance to the County Auditor within 15 days after its passage.

SECTION SEVEN.

That subject to the provisions of Section 727.24 of the Revised Code, the City Manager is authorized and directed, as soon as the funds are available, to execute and implement the contract for the improvement and the improvement shall be financed as provided in Resolution No. 7761.

SECTION EIGHT.

That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION NINE.

That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in said City, and for further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective to provide for the construction of the improvement which is needed to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrian and vehicular traffic, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
