Passed June 9, 2014

SECTION FOUR.

That the portion of the cost of the improvement to be assessed in accordance with Resolution No. 7805 shall be assessed in the manner and the number of installments provided and on the lots and lands described, in that resolution.

SECTION FIVE.

That the estimated special assessments previously prepared and filed in the office of the Clerk of Council and as equalized by the Assessment Equalization Board are adopted.

SECTION SIX.

That the Clerk of Council shall deliver certified copies of this ordinance to the County Auditor within 15 days after its passage.

SECTION SEVEN.

That subject to the provisions of Section 727.24 of the Revised Code, the City Manager is authorized and directed, as soon as the funds are available, to execute and implement the contract for the improvement and the improvement shall be financed as provided in Resolution No. 7805.

SECTION EIGHT.

That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION NINE.

That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in said City, and for further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective to provide for the construction of the improvement which is needed to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrian
