The following chart provides dates and deadlines per tax year for filing new or renewal levies

Levy Expires Tax year 2020	May 4, 2021 Election Board of Elections Filing Deadline February 3, 2021	August 3, 2021 Election Board of Election Filing Deadline May 5, 2021	Nov 2, 2021 Election Board of Elections Filing Deadline August 4, 2021
Levy Expires Tax year 2021	November 2, 2021 Election Board of Elections Filing Deadline August 4, 2021	May & November 2022	Additional Tries if Needed

Election Laws have changed for placing a levy on the ballot. This information can be referenced at www.sos.state.oh.us; Ohio Ballot Questions and Issues Handbook; Candidate & Local Issue Information. Consult your legal advisor to ensure levy resolutions are properly prepared.

The Board of Elections deadline is 4:00 pm on the above dates

For those entities that will have a levy placed on the ballot here are a few quick reminders:

- ✓ Law allows 3 tries for passage
- ✓ Levies expiring “tax year” 2020 may be voted May 4, August 3, or November 2, 2021.
- ✓ Levies expiring “tax year” 2021 may be first voted November 2, 2021
- ✓ Requires 2 meetings to be placed on ballot. 1) Request for County Auditor to certify amount or millage needed. 2) Resolution or ordinance to proceed with certificate for Board of Election.
- ✓ If an entity elects to be on the ballot for the August 3, 2021 election, they are required to prepay 65% of the estimated election cost to the Board of Elections.

Please peruse the Schedule “B” to verify Levy dates and rates.

If your subdivision has a Levy expiring tax year 2020 or 2021 enclosed is the DTE 27 for your district.
