


**CERTIFICATE OF ANNUAL LEVY**  
**CHIPPEWA SUBDISTRICT OF THE**  
**MUSKINGUM WATERSHED CONSERVANCY DISTRICT**

**This is to Certify:**

1. That on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010, the Board of Directors of the Chippewa Subdistrict of the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District duly levied a maintenance assessment for the year 2010, in the aggregate sum of \$356,196.48 for the account of the Maintenance Fund of said Subdistrict. That said maintenance assessment has been duly apportioned to the benefited properties and public corporations in said Subdistrict in proportion to benefits and that the amounts of said maintenance assessment imposed upon the properties and public corporations in said Subdistrict have been recorded in the Conservancy Assessment Record of the Chippewa Subdistrict of the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District.
2. That the Conservancy Assessment Record of the Chippewa Subdistrict of the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District contains a true and correct record of the Annual Levy of 2010 and of the maintenance assessment for the year 2010 as determined, ordered, and levied by the Board of Directors of the Chippewa Subdistrict of the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2010.
3. That the said amounts of said Annual Levy and of said maintenance assessment shall be collectible and payable in the year 2011 in the sums specified at the same time that the state and county taxes are due and collectible.
4. Following here is: (A) The descriptions of the property opposite the names of the owners; and (B) The total amount of the annual levy on each piece of property and on each public corporation for the account of all funds and the amount of each item making up the total.
