Wayne County Dog Warden Katelyn Lehman, and Wayne County Auditor Jarra Underwood have partnered with online dog licensing platform Docupet to increase efficiency and make reuniting dogs and their owners more of a streamlined process.

Lehman and Underwood want to remind pet owners that dog licensing will end Tuesday January 31. As of February 1, all license purchased will include a penalty equal to the licensing fee.

Docupet provides a quick and easy way to license your pet from the comfort of your own home. Tags can still be purchased in person at the Wayne County Auditor's office, or at the Wayne County Dog Shelter for those who do not wish to use online access.

3-year license \$48

Lifetime license \$160

Kennel license \$80 (Can only be purchased at the Auditors office)
