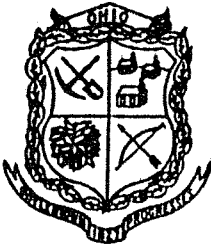

AGREEMENT

We, Keith J. & Deborah L. Hanawalt, being non-residents of the Village of Doylestown, Ohio, and desiring to gain permission of the Village of Doylestown for sanitary sewer service for the property located at 13165 Coal Bank Rd., Chippewa Township, State of Ohio do hereby agree to the following:

1. We have applied for and paid the fee for a permit for the above improvement to the Village of Doylestown, Ohio, whether or not a permit and fee are required by any other authority.
2. We have installed the above improvement according to the specifications required under the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Doylestown. Such improvement may, at the option of the Village of Doylestown, include improvements to the infrastructure by which the Village would gain access to maintain the lines. Should a conflict occur, the Village of Doylestown shall have the authority to declare what specifications are to be followed.
3. We agree not to hold the Village of Doylestown liable for any and all occurrences concerning the installation, specifications or inspection of this improvement.
4. We understand that should we violate any of the terms of this Agreement, the Village of Doylestown, shall have the authority to shut off all sanitary sewer service to the above improvement upon reasonable notice.
5. We agree that any further repairs of improvement to the above shall be bound by the terms of this Agreement.
6. We agree to indemnify and save the Village of Doylestown harmless from any liability of any kind arising out of the installation and maintenance of the improvement made pursuant to the terms of the Agreement.
7. The terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be binding upon ourselves and our heirs, devisees, successors and assigns and shall run with the realty which we own that is subject to this agreement.

8. House trailers or mobile homes are specifically denied the right to tap in or use the sanitary sewer service.

ORDINANCE 96-34

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF DOYLESTOWN, AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 3-71, PROVIDING THERE WILL BE AN EXTENSION OF
SANITARY SEWER SERVICE BEYOND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID
VILLAGE TO THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 13165 COAL BANK ROAD,
CHIPPewa TOWNSHIP, STATE OF OHIO AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Affairs has requested Council to adopt legislation providing sanitary sewer service be extended beyond the corporate limits of said municipality of the Village of Doylestown, to the property located at 13165 Coal Bank Road, Chippewa Township, State of Ohio, and

WHEREAS, this Council is of the opinion that such a policy is desirable in order to facilitate orderly annexation of surrounding territories to this municipality, and
WHEREAS, the Village of Doylestown is in immediate need to the improvement to maintain the peace and public safety of the Village of Doylestown.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Doylestown, County of Wayne, three fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION ONE.

That Ordinance No. 3-71 be amended to extend sanitary sewer service beyond the corporate limits of the Village of Doylestown, to the property located at 13165 Coal Bank Rd., Chippewa Township, State of Ohio

SECTION TWO.

That because of the immediate need to make sanitary sewer improvements which lie beyond the corporate limits of the Village of Doylestown, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the peace, health and safety and shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage.
